

ORDINANCE NO. 2011 - 99

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH VOGELPOHL FIRE EQUIPMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$26,520 FOR THE PURCHASE OF 65 SCBA AIR BOTTLES TO REPLACE EXPIRING SCBA AIR BOTTLES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has received a quote to purchase 65 SCBA air bottles to replace expiring SCBA air bottles; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has determined that these SCBA air bottles from Vogelpohl Fire Equipment is the best price for this replacement purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason determines that Vogelpohl Fire Equipment is the best supplier of the 65 SCBA air bottles, and authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract with Vogelpohl Fire Equipment for \$26,520.00 for said purchase.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay to Vogelpohl Fire Equipment the amount due under the contract referred to in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate purchase of the SCBA bottles and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date in order to replace the expiring SCBA bottles.
