

ORDINANCE NO. 2011 -117

ACCEPTING A PROPOSAL, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,885.00, FOR THE DEMOLITION OF THE OLD FIRE STATION 51, FROM BRUNK EXCAVATING, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has solicited proposals for the demolition of the old Fire Station 51; and

WHEREAS, the proposals have been reviewed for responsiveness to the City's requirements; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Brunk Excavating, in the total fee amount of \$16,885.00, is considered the best and most responsive of the proposals received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the contract for the demolition of the old Fire Station 51 is awarded to Brunk Excavating at the proposed amount of \$16,885.00.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contract documents with Brunk Excavating on behalf of the City of Mason.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Brunk Excavating on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$16,885.00.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of this municipality, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to demolish the structure at the earliest possible date.
