

ORDINANCE NO. 2012 - 59

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT WITH HAMILTON TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the City of Mason is currently a party to a mutual aid agreement for law enforcement with numerous police agencies throughout Warren County; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to enter into a separate mutual agreement for law enforcement with Hamilton Township, Ohio, in order to more fully address mutual aid responsibilities during off-duty assignments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Mutual Aid Agreement for Law Enforcement with Hamilton Township, Ohio, substantially in the form of the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
