

RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 2

RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING AND REQUESTING THAT THE PORTION OF UNITED STATES ROUTE 42 IN WARREN COUNTY BE DESIGNATED AS THE WARREN COUNTY VETERANS HIGHWAY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the veterans of Warren County have made significant contributions in the service of their country; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Mason desires to honor the service and sacrifice of these veterans; and

WHEREAS, every citizen of Warren County owes a great debt of gratitude to the patriotic men and women who have served their country in times of great need; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason would urge that the City of Lebanon and the Warren County Commissioners join in this effort to designate the portion of U.S. 42 in Warren County as the "Warren County Veterans Highway."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Mason does hereby petition and request that its State Representative introduce the necessary legislation to designate that portion of United States Route 42 in the corporate limits of the City of Mason as the "Warren County Veterans Highway."

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Mason requests and recommends that the Council of the City of Lebanon and the Warren County Commissioners make similar petitions to the appropriate state legislators to further designate the entire portion of United States Route 42 in Warren County as the "Warren County Veterans Highway."

Section 3. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to send certified copies of this Resolution to State Representative Pete Beck, the Council of the City of Lebanon, and the Warren County Commissioners.

Section 4. That this Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and general welfare of the people of this municipality and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to take all necessary steps to honor the veterans of Warren County at the earliest possible date.
