

ORDINANCE NO. 2012 - 74

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO WETLAND FOUNDATION TO PURCHASE WETLAND MITIGATION CREDITS FOR THE PURPOSE OF WETLAND MITIGATION DUE TO THE BETHANY ROAD ROUNDABOUT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Wetland Foundation to purchase wetland mitigation credits in the Big Darby Hellbranch Wetland Mitigation Bank for the Bethany Road and Mason-Montgomery Road Roundabout Project, as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the agreement and begin construction of the road at the earliest possible date.
