

ORDINANCE NO. 2012 - 89

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WILO USA LLC FOR THE 741 & WESTERN ROW PUMP REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$123,011.00, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids for the construction of the 741 & Western Row Pump Replacement Project were received and opened at 3:00 PM on November 30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, WILO USA LLC has been determined to be the lowest and best bidder, with a total bid of \$123,011.00 for the 741 & Western Row Pump Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, City staff has reviewed the bids which were opened on November 30, 2012, and has recommended awarding the contract for the 741 & Western Row Pump Replacement Project to Wilo USA LLC for the total bid amount of \$123,011.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Wilo USA LLC, in the amount of \$123,011.00, is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the 741 & Western Row Pump Replacement Project.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Wilo USA LLC for the 741 & Western Row Pump Replacement Project, according to the plans and specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Wilo USA LLC an amount not to exceed \$123,011.00 for the 741 & Western Row Pump Replacement Project.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract at the earliest possible date.
