

ORDINANCE NO. 2012 - 90

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HORTON EMERGENCY VEHICLES FOR THE REMOUNTING AND PURCHASE OF A 2013 HORTON MEDIUM DUTY MODULAR BODY MEDIC VEHICLE FOR USE BY THE CITY OF MASON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase and remounting of medic vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Horton Emergency Vehicles, was the best bidder with a bid of \$142,496.71 for the remounting and purchase of a 2013 Medium Duty, 167 inch Modular Body Medic vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's Medic vehicle specifications and agrees that Horton Emergency Vehicles. is the best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Horton Emergency Vehicles for the remounting and purchase of a 2013 Horton Medium Duty, 167 inch Modular Body Medic Vehicle.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Horton Emergency Vehicles. the sum of up to \$142,496.71 for said medic vehicle.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to execute the contract prior to the expiration date of the bid.
