

ORDINANCE NO. 2013 - 49

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL FOR THE CITYWIDE SIGNAL AND FIBER INTERCONNECT PROJECT FROM TEC ENGINEERING, INC., IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FEE OF \$193,475.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Mason received a proposal to perform preliminary engineering and final design services for the Citywide Signal and Fiber Interconnect Project; and

WHEREAS, TEC Engineering, Inc. submitted a proposal in an amount not to exceed fee of \$193,475.00, is considered the best and most qualified consultant to complete the study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the contract for the Citywide Signal and Fiber Interconnect Project is awarded to TEC Engineering, Inc. at the not to exceed proposed fee amount of \$193,475.00.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with TEC Engineering, Inc. on behalf of the City of Mason.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to TEC Engineering, Inc. on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$193,475.00.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
