

ORDINANCE NO. 2013 - 106

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE LOWEST AND BEST BID FOR THE WILLOW BROOKE REGIONAL LIFT STATION PROJECT FROM FORD DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,532,890.00, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason received on December 3, 2013 competitive bids for construction of the Willow Brooke Subdivision Regional Lift Station Project; and

WHEREAS, tabulation and analysis of the bids received on December 3, 2013 indicate that the lowest and best bid was provided by Ford Development Corporation in the total amount of \$1,532,890.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the contract for the Willow Brooke Subdivision Regional Lift Station Project is awarded to Ford Development Corporation, at the bid amount of \$1,532,890.00.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contract documents with Ford Development Corporation on behalf of the City of Mason.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Ford Development Corporation, on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$1,532,890.00.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The need for said emergency is the necessity to begin the Willow Brooke Regional Lift Station Project as soon as possible.
