

ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - 134

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH HENRY P. THOMPSON COMPANY FOR PANEL AND VARIABLE FREQUENCY DRIVES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$35,000.

WHEREAS, the City of Mason, during the operation and maintenance of the Community Center pools, discovered the chemical feed system not working properly; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the system upgrades be completed at the earliest possible time in order to protect public health; and

WHEREAS, Henry P. Thompson Company was contacted by City staff and asked to furnish prices for the required control panel and variable frequency drives; and

WHEREAS, Henry P. Thompson Company can supply the system equipment for an amount not to exceed of \$35,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Council finds it acceptable, in accordance with information supplied in advance of the furnishing by Henry P. Thompson Company of the system equipment, to proceed with said work in an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Henry P. Thompson Company for the system equipment.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to pay Henry P. Thompson Company an amount not to exceed \$35,000.00 upon execution of a purchase agreement between the City of Mason and Henry P. Thompson Company.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
