

ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 59

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BLACKBOX FOR NETWORK FIBER INFRASTRUCTURE INSTALLATION TO CONNECT THE NEW FUEL DEPOT AT THE MASON SERVICE CENTER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,000 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were solicited for the network fiber infrastructure installation to connect the new fuel depot at the Mason Service Center; and

WHEREAS, Blackbox was the best bidder with a bid of \$15,000 for network fiber infrastructure installation to connect the new fuel depot to the fuel depot;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Blackbox for the network fiber infrastructure installation to connect the new fuel depot at the Mason Service Center.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay Blackbox the total sum of \$15,000 for said network fiber installation.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The need for said emergency is the necessity to provide and install the equipment as soon as possible to allow for vehicle maintenance operations to begin at the new service center.
