

RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - 2

**CONCURRING WITH THE APPOINTMENT OF PAT CLEMENTS TO
THE WARREN COUNTY 911 PLANNING COMMITTEE AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Section 5507.06 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for the creation of
a 911 Planning Committee; and

WHEREAS, Section 5507.06 also sets forth the make-up of said committee; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Warren County have
recommended that Pat Clements, City Manager of the City of Lebanon, be appointed to one
of the established seats on the Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason,
Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City of Mason, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section
5507.06, hereby concurs with the appointment of Pat Clements, City Manager of the City of
Lebanon, to the Warren County 911 Planning Committee.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of
the people of this municipality, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.
The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to establish the make-up of the 911
Planning Committee pursuant to the time restrictions of the Ohio Revised Code.
