

ORDINANCE NO. 99-20

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MASON AND MASON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT REGARDING ALLOCATION OF TAXES COLLECTED


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, **six (6)** members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement between the City of Mason and Mason City School District relative to the allocation of taxes collected.


Section 2. That the terms of said Agreement shall be in substantial compliance with the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
