

ORDINANCE NO. 99-24

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WARREN COUNTY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A VIDEO ARRAIGNMENT SYSTEM IN THE MASON MUNICIPAL COURT**

WHEREAS, Warren County has contracted with Mid-State Security for the installation of a video arraignment system in the Mason Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason can purchase equipment from Mid-State Security which will allow the City to tap into the new video arraignment system for the sum of \$21,182.00; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to purchase and install equipment in order to utilize the video arraignment system.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, **six (6)** members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Warren County for the purchase and installation of equipment to allow the City of Mason to tap into the video arraignment system being implemented by Warren County.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay to Warren County the sum of \$21,182.00 for the purchase and installation of said equipment.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
