

ORDINANCE NO. 99-32

ACCEPTING A PROPOSAL UNDER THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH 32 FORD-MERCURY, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 1999 VANS

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of vans;
and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to purchase two vans for use by the Public Utilities and Public Works Departments; and

WHEREAS, 32 Ford-Mercury, Inc. was the lowest and best bidder for the purchase of vans, with bids as follows:

Van for Public Utilities Department (without windows)	\$24,147.25
Van for Public Works Department (with windows)	\$24,778.25

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, **six (6)** members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's specifications for vans and agrees that 32 Ford-Mercury, Inc. is the lowest and best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with 32 Ford-Mercury, Inc. for the purchase of two (2) 1999 vans.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay 32 Ford-Mercury, Inc. the sum of \$48,925.50 for said vans.


Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
