

ORDINANCE NO. 99-62

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH INTERNATIONAL SAFETY INSTRUMENTS, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO THERMAL IMAGING CAMERAS FOR THE CITY OF MASON FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, bids were received for the purchase of thermal imaging cameras for the City of Mason Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, International Safety Instruments, Inc. was the best bidder with a bid of \$24,500.00 for the purchase of two (2) thermal imaging cameras.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, **seven (7)** members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of International Safety Instruments, Inc. in the amount of \$24,500.00 is hereby accepted as the best bid for the purchase of two (2) thermal imaging cameras for the City of Mason Fire Department.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with International Safety Instruments, Inc. for the purchase of two thermal imaging cameras, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said International Safety Instruments, Inc. the sum of \$24,500.00 for the purchase of said cameras.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
