

ORDINANCE NO. 99-94

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WESTERMAN COMPANY FOR THE SCADA SOFTWARE UPGRADE AND SYSTEM CONFIGURATION TO INSURE Y2K COMPLIANCE FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

WHEREAS, bids were received for the software upgrade to insure Y2K compliance for the Water Treatment Plant and water distribution system; and

WHEREAS, Westerman Companies was the best bidder with a bid of \$9,788.00 for said SCADA software upgrade and system configuration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, **seven (7)** members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Westerman Companies in the amount of \$9,788.00 is hereby accepted as the best bid for the SCADA software upgrade and system configuration to insure Y2K compliance for the Water Treatment Plant and water distribution system.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Westerman Companies for said SCADA software upgrade and system configuration, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Westerman Companies the sum of \$9,788.00 for the SCADA software upgrade and system configuration.


Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
