

ORDINANCE NO. 99-120

REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE MAIN STREET AND U.S. 42 TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADE

WHEREAS, bids were sought for the Main Street and U.S. 42 traffic signal upgrade; and


WHEREAS, the City has determined that the bids opened on July 14, 1999 exceed the engineer's estimate for the project and therefore should be rejected.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, **seven (7)** members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That all bids received for the Main Street and U.S. 42 traffic signal upgrade are hereby rejected.


Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
