

ORDINANCE NO. 99-168

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE CINCINNATI AIR CONDITIONING CO. FOR THE MECHANICAL CONSTRUCTION WORK NECESSARY FOR THE ADDITION TO MASON FIRE STATION #52 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were received for the mechanical construction work necessary for the addition to Mason Fire Station #52; and

WHEREAS, The Cincinnati Air Conditioning Co. was the best bidder with a bid of \$48,500.00 for said mechanical construction work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, **seven (7)** members thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the bid of The Cincinnati Air Conditioning Co. in the amount of \$48,500.00 is hereby accepted as the best bid for the mechanical construction work necessary for the addition to Mason Fire Station #52.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with The Cincinnati Air Conditioning Co. for the mechanical construction work to Mason Fire Station #52, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said The Cincinnati Air Conditioning Co. the sum of \$48,500.00 for said work.



That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to award the contract and begin the work at the earliest possible date.
