

ORDINANCE NO. 99-178

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ANTHEM BENEFIT ADMINISTRATORS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADMINISTERING THE EMPLOYEE MEDICAL AND LIFE INSURANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Mason sought the most efficient administration of its employee medical and life insurance coverage; and

WHEREAS, prospective vendors were encouraged to submit proposals which included provisions for the retention of the maximum reasonable medical financial risk; and


WHEREAS, after careful review, the proposal for a partially self-funded plan submitted by Anthem Benefit Administrators is deemed to be the best proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, **seven (7)** members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Anthem Benefit Administrators for the purpose of administering the City's partially self-funded employee medical and life insurance coverage program.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
