

ORDINANCE NO. 99-188

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH 32 FORD MERCURY FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR (4) 2000 FORD CROWN VICTORIA SEDANS

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has advertised and received bids for the purchase of police cruisers; and

WHEREAS, 32 Ford Mercury was the best bidder for the purchase four (4) 2000 Crown Victoria Sedans with a bid of \$85,674.00 for use as police cruisers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, **seven (7)** members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the City of Mason accepts the State's police cruiser specifications and agrees that 32 Ford Mercury is the best bidder.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with 32 Ford Mercury for the purchase of four (4) 2000 Crown Victoria Sedans for use as police cruisers.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay 32 Ford Mercury the sum of \$85,674.00 for said Crown Victorias.


Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
