ORDINANCE NO. 2000-103

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE MASON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason and the Mason City School District are jointly developing a site for a recreation center in conjunction with construction of a new high school; and

WHEREAS, the land under which said site is located is titled in the name of the City of Mason; and

WHEREAS, the Mason City School District needs to move ahead in certain site improvements and development of the property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio six (6) members thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a License Agreement with the Mason City School District to authorize entry onto the City property by the Mason City School District to begin the necessary site and development work in accordance with the City Planning Commission's approved plan.

Section 2: That said Agreement shall be in substantially the same form as the License Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

<u>Section 3</u>: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare, and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need for the Mason City School District to initiate development work immediately.
