

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-11

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH STATE STREET CONSULTANTS FOR LEGISLATIVE CONSULTING AND/OR LOBBYING AND RELATED SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, **seven (7)** members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with State Street Consultants for legislative consulting and/or lobbying and related services, in accordance with the proposal submitted by State Street Consultants, which proposal is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said State Street Consultants the amount of \$3,000.00 per month for a period of six (6) months.


Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to have the consulting services available at the earliest possible date.

In consideration for SSC's services, you agree to pay SSC monthly as follows:


January 1, 2000 through, June 30, 2000 \$3,000


Our initial invoice is enclosed for your approval.
