ORDINANCE NO. 2000-111

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MASON TO FILE AN APPLICATION AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING FUNDS THROUGH THE TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the quality of urban life is enhanced by the installation of bicycle paths; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason recognizes the benefits of providing pedestrian safety to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, funding for the planning and installation of bicycle paths is available through the Ohio Department of Transportation's Transportation Enhancement Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason is hereby authorized to apply for and, if awarded, enter into agreement with the Department of Transportation to administer a grant to implement said program, and that the City Manager is authorized to sign said agreement.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City of Mason hereby requests the Ohio Department of Transportation's Transportation Enhancement Program to consider and fund its application project.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Clerk be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Ohio Department of Transportation's Transportation Enhancement Program.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
