## ORDINANCE NO. 2000-145

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION DISTRICT 10 STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/ OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE ANY AGREEMENTS OR DOCUMENTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason is planning to make road widening capital improvements:

- 1. on Mason-Montgomery Road from U.S. 42 to the I & O Bridge;
- 2. on U.S. 42 from Tylersville Road to Fifth Avenue; and
- 3. on U.S. 42 from Tylersville Road to Butler-Warren Road.

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements herein above described are considered to be a priority need for the community and are qualified projects under the OPWC programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, 6 members thereto concurring:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to prepare and submit an application to participate in the Ohio Public Works Commission District 10 State Capital Improvement and/or Local Transportation Improvement Program(s) and to execute any agreements or documents as required for the following road widening projects:

- 1. on Mason-Montgomery Road from U.S. 42 to the I & O Bridge;
- 2. on U.S. 42 from Tylersville Road to Fifth Avenue; and
- 3. on U.S. 42 from Tylersville Road to Butler-Warren Road.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the City Manager is hereby further authorized to execute on behalf of the City any agreements or documents as may be necessary and appropriate to obtain this financial assistance.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
