ORDINANCE NO. 2000-20

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TELE-VAC ENVIRONMENTAL FOR SEWER PIPE TELEVISING AND LIGHT CLEANING SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City entered into the contract for engineering services to evaluate flooding along the trunk sewer line in the south-central Mason area during times of heavy rainfall; and

WHEREAS, the engineer has requested that the sewer trunk be televised and cleaned in order to complete the necessary engineering services to identify the cause of the flooding; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the flooding of the south-central Mason area poses an emergency situation which effects the public peace, safety and welfare of the community of the City of Mason; and

WHEREAS, Tele-Vac Environmental has submitted a proposal to perform the necessary televising and light cleaning services for a total of two dollars and twenty-five cents (\$2.25) per foot; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it advisable and in the best interest of the community to award the contract to Tele-Vac Environmental pursuant to their proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six

(6) members elected thereto concurring:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the City of Mason hereby accepts the proposal submitted by Tele-Vac Environmental pursuant to their proposal.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Tele-Vac Environmental for sewer pipe televising and light cleaning pursuant to the proposal.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Tele-Vac Environmental \$2.25 per lineal foot which is estimated to be an amount of \$15,750.00.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to have the sewer pipe televising and light cleaning completed as soon as possible.
