ROLL CALL

Members of Council present were as follows: Jim Fox, Dick Staten, Tom Muennich, Peter Beck, Betty Davis, Charlene Pelfrey and John McCurley.

STORMWATER ADVISORY COMMITTEE

David Riggs introduced members of the Stormwater Advisory Committee. A presentation followed outlining the following topics:

1. Stormwater Policy
2. Existing Stormwater Problems
3. Stormwater Program Costs
4. Stormwater Financing Options
5. Stormwater Advisory Committee Recommendations

Program costs were discussed in more depth with three categories being considered.

- A. Capital Improvement Program
- B. Planning and Management
- C. Operation and Maintenance

It was also mentioned the City should move ahead with revising regulations for the purpose of restricting building within a flood plain.


The general discussion continued on this subject. It was decided the City's current path is not keeping up with the stormwater problems. The Committee listed 80+ new projects that should be reviewed and prioritized.

Mayor McCurley thanked the citizens that have volunteered to participate in the detailed study of this issue.
