

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-11

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LAW ENFORCEMENT MUTUAL AID ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT WITH WARREN COUNTY AND ADJACENT POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS REGARDING PARTICIPATION IN THE TACTICAL RESPONSE UNIT

WHEREAS, the Warren County Sheriff, and the Cities of Mason, Lebanon, Franklin and Springboro are engaged in the provision of law enforcement services within their respective jurisdictions and, pursuant to law enforcement mutual aid agreements, to other jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the above mentioned political subdivisions have personnel trained to provide tactical response in specialized situations requiring a law enforcement response, and own equipment which is used in tactical responses; and

WHEREAS, the above mentioned political subdivision have cooperated in using such personnel and equipment to form a Tactical Response Unit, and wish to enter into an agreement setting forth guidelines for disbursement of contributions of monies and equipment received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio **seven (7)** members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Assistance Agreement regarding participation in the Tactical Response Unit with Warren County and adjacent political subdivisions, and that the terms and conditions of such Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Assistance Agreement shall be as set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
