

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-111

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FERGUSON STEEL COMPANY FOR STRUCTURAL AND MISCELLANEOUS STEEL NECESSARY FOR THE NEW MASON MUNICIPAL CENTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids have been received for structural and miscellaneous steel necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center; and

WHEREAS, Ferguson Steel is the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$1,310,000.00 for said structural and miscellaneous steel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Ferguson Steel in the amount of \$1,310,000.00 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the structural and miscellaneous steel necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ferguson Steel for the structural and miscellaneous steel necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Ferguson Steel an amount not to exceed \$1,310,000.00 for said structural and miscellaneous steel.



That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to begin construction at the earliest possible date to meet the completion deadline of the project.
