

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-117

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CTL ENGINEERING, INC. FOR THE TESTING AND INSPECTION SERVICES NECESSARY FOR THE NEW MASON MUNICIPAL CENTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, proposals have been received for the testing and inspection services necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center; and

WHEREAS, CTL Engineering, Inc. has made the best proposal for said testing and inspection services in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of CTL Engineering, Inc. is hereby accepted as the best proposal for the testing and inspection services necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center at the rates set forth above.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with CTL Engineering, Inc. for the testing and inspection services necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center, according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said CTL Engineering, Inc. as set forth above for said testing and inspection services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to begin construction at the earliest possible date to meet the completion deadline of the project.
