

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-136

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH
STEPHEN GROSS & SONS, INC. FOR THE GENERAL TRADES WORK
NECESSARY FOR THE NEW MASON MUNICIPAL CENTER**

WHEREAS, bids have been received for the general trades work necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center, generally consisting of metal framing and drywall, ceilings, doors and hardware, interior trim and specialties, and general conditions; and

WHEREAS, Stephen Gross & Sons, Inc. is the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$3,022,807 for said general trades work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Stephen Gross & Sons, Inc. in the amount of \$3,022,807 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the general trades work necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Stephen Gross & Sons, Inc. for the general trades work necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center, according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Stephen Gross & Sons, Inc. an amount not to exceed \$3,022,807 for said general trades work.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
