

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-138

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GREENVILLE GLASS COMPANY, INC. FOR THE WINDOWS NECESSARY FOR THE NEW MASON MUNICIPAL CENTER

WHEREAS, bids have been received for providing, preparing and installing the exterior windows necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center; and

WHEREAS, Greenville Glass Company, Inc. is the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$383,400 for said windows.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Greenville Glass Company, Inc. in the amount of \$383,400 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the windows necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Greenville Glass Company, Inc. for the windows necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Greenville Glass Company, Inc. an amount not to exceed \$383,400 for said windows.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
