

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-142

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH COST OF WISCONSIN INC. FOR THE FOUNTAIN NECESSARY FOR THE NEW MASON MUNICIPAL CENTER

WHEREAS, bids have been received for the fountain necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center; and

WHEREAS, Cost of Wisconsin Inc. is the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$410,000 for said fountain.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Cost of Wisconsin Inc. in the amount of \$410,000 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the fountain necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Cost of Wisconsin Inc. for the fountain necessary for the new Mason Municipal Center, according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Cost of Wisconsin Inc. an amount not to exceed \$410,000 for said fountain.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
