

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-151

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROVIDE \$10,000.00 TO THE BUTLER-WARREN BICYCLE COALITION FOR THE MIAMI-2-MIAMI TRAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR A REGIONAL BIKE PATH

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has been working on a collaborative effort forming a coalition with communities in Butler and Warren Counties in order to obtain grant monies for a Miami-2-Miami Bicycle Trail Feasibility Study; and

WHEREAS, the Butler-Warren Bicycle Coalition has received a grant in the amount of \$61,500 to cover approximately half of the anticipated cost of the study; and

WHEREAS, the Coalition is seeking a \$10,000 commitment from each member community in order to proceed with the feasibility study; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason wishes to support the Coalition in this endeavor through payment of \$10,000 for the feasibility study.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to commit the sum of \$10,000 to the Butler-Warren Bicycle Coalition for the Miami-2-Miami Bicycle Trail Feasibility Study.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay the sum of \$10,000 to the Butler-Warren Bicycle Coalition for said study.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
