

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-161

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF MASON TO NOMINATE MICHAEL HECKER, DIRECTOR OF PARKS & RECREATION, DAVID R. RIGGS, ASSISTANT CITY ENGINEER, AND TERESA SCHULTE, CLERK OF COUNCIL, TO SERVE AS A MEMBERS OF NATURAL RESOURCES ASSISTANCE COUNCIL IN THE 10TH PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION DISTRICT, STATE OF OHIO

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Public Works Commission has called for nominations of individuals to the local District Resources Assistance Council as part of the Clean Ohio Grant Program, which program provides reimbursement assistance for acquisition, development of open space, and riparian areas for park and recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, these individuals will review applications and make recommendations for funding for the District 10 Clean Ohio Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason Parks & Recreation Director Michael Hecker is imminently qualified to represent the City of Mason park system and has education and experience to serve as a member on this Committee.

WHEREAS, David R. Riggs, Assistant City Engineer, has the qualification to serve as a municipal representative since he has been intimately involved with Issue 2 grants; and

WHEREAS, Teresa Schulte is qualified to serve as a conservation representative in that she was the person who organized and formed the City of Mason's Tree Preservation Committee and headed up its effort in that regard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager of City of Mason is hereby authorized to nominate Michael Hecker, Director of Parks and Recreation, to serve as a member of the Natural Resources Assistance Council in the 10th Public Works Commission District, State of Ohio, as a part of the Clean Ohio Grant Program.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to nominate David R. Riggs, Assistant City Engineer, to serve as the Municipal Representative of the National Resources Assistance Council in the 10th Public Works Commission District, State of Ohio, as a part of the Clean Ohio Grant Program.


Section 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to nominate Teresa Schulte, Clerk of Council, who has organized and formed the City of Mason's Tree Preservation Committee and headed up its efforts, and is hereby to be nominated as the Conservation Member of the Natural Resources Assistance Council in the 10th Public Works Commission District, State of Ohio, as a part of the Clean Ohio Grant Program.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
