

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-215

**AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO CONTRIBUTE
UNCLAIMED BIKES TO OAK HARBOR COMMUNITY
CHURCH FOR THE BIKE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Mason Police Department has unclaimed bikes in its custody for ninety days or more; and

WHEREAS, Oak Harbor Community Church, a nonprofit organization, no part of the net income of which inures to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual and no substantial part of the activities of which consists of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, is in need of bikes for the Bike Program to provide for the needy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the Chief of Police is hereby authorized to contribute the bikes, which are in the possession of the City of Mason Police Department and are unclaimed for ninety days or more, to the Oak Harbor Community Church Bike Program to provide for the needy.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period provided by law.
