

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-44

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TENNIS TECHNOLOGY, INC. FOR THE HERITAGE OAK PARK TENNIS AND BASKETBALL COURT RECONSTRUCTION

WHEREAS, bids were received for the Heritage Oak Park tennis and basketball court reconstruction; and

WHEREAS, Tennis Technology, Inc. was the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$99,985.00 for said reconstruction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Tennis Technology, Inc. in the amount of \$99,985.00 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the Heritage Oak Park tennis and basketball court reconstruction .


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Tennis Technology, Inc. for said reconstruction, according to the specifications set forth by the City.

Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Tennis Technology, Inc. an amount not to exceed \$99,985.00 for said reconstruction.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
