

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-56

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACQUIRE PERMANENT
TAKES AND TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENTS FOR THE
MASON-MONTGOMERY ROAD WIDENING PROJECT,
AUTHORIZING PAYMENT THEREFOR AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to acquire permanent takes and temporary construction easements for the Mason-Montgomery Road Widening Project, which permanent takes and temporary construction easements are more particularly described on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payment for said permanent takes and temporary construction easements to the property owners in the amounts set forth on Exhibit "A".

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to acquire the property and proceed with the Mason-Montgomery Road Widening Project at the earliest possible date.
