941.03 SEWER SYSTEM EXPANSION FEES.

- (a) Residential. Effective June 1, 2001, the expansion charge for a single-family residence shall be two thousand six hundred fifty dollars (\$2650) for a 6-inch sewer tap. For multi-family apartment complexes, the expansion fee shall be two thousand six hundred fifty dollars (\$2650) for each family unit. The charge for a single-family residence and each family unit of a multi-family apartment complex shall be two thousand eight hundred nine dollars (\$2809) effective January 1, 2002. The charge shall be two thousand nine hundred seventy-seven dollars and fifty-four cents (\$2977.54) effective January 1, 2003. The charge shall be three thousand two hundred seventy-five dollars and twenty-nine cents (\$3275.29) effective January 1, 2004.

941.08 RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE

All funds received are to be deposited to the operating account for the Sewer Department.

- (a) Residential Users. The following rates shall be charged for single and multi-family dwellings and trailer parks. The rates are based upon water used and are per family unit as defined in Section 941.07 (a). For dwellings without water meters, the charge for sewer service will be based on 4,000 gallons per month.

961.04 CHARGES AND BILLING

- (a) The following charges are hereby established for waste collection, in the City:
- (1) For each single-family unit, the charge shall be nine dollars and seventy five cents (\$9.75) per month effective June 1, 2001.
 - (2) For each multi-family unit and for each trailer, the charge shall be nine dollars and seventy five cents (\$9.75) effective June 1, 2001.
 - (2) For each industrial and commercial establishment, the charge shall be sixteen dollars (\$16.00) per month effective May 1, 1997. The charge for each industrial and commercial establishment shall be increased to seventeen dollars (\$17.00) effective May 1, 1998. The charge for each industrial and commercial establishment shall be increased to eighteen dollars (\$18.00) effective May 1, 1999. If the total weekly collection from any such establishment is four cans or less, application may be made to the City for a reduction of charge to the current rate then in effect for single-family and multi-family residential customers. If the average weekly collection is more than ten cans, dumpsters are required.
