

RESOLUTION 2001-14

**PROCLAIMING MAY 7 - 11, 2001 AS PUBLIC SERVICE
RECOGNITION WEEK**

WHEREAS, government employees, with their commitment to excellence and diversity of skills, contribute significantly to the leadership of the United States in the world. These dedicated men and women are a valuable natural resource, serving at all levels of government, and dealing with nearly every aspect of life; and

WHEREAS, government employees provide such a broad range of services that few citizens remain unaffected by their work. They defend our nation, enforce the laws, help protect the environment, maintain vital transportation systems, ensure our water supply is provided in a healthy manner, help parents teach their children, and perform countless other vital tasks for society. These public servants have also helped develop innovative technologies to show the way in critical fields; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the indispensable contribution make by government employees, the week commencing May 7, 2001, and ending May 11, 2001, is designated as "Public Service Recognition Week".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, hereby designates and proclaims the week of May 7 - 11, 2001 as "Public Service Recognition Week".

Section 2. That the citizens of Mason and the entire United States, along with all levels of government, are encouraged to participate in appropriate activities to recognize the vital role of government employees.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
