

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-17

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR
STORMWATER USER FEE**

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2001-61, adopted by the City Council on April 23, 2001, places upon the City Council the obligation to establish the rates and fees to be charged for stormwater user fee; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended to the City Council a rate schedule which should be established.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Mason, Warren County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The rates to be charged for the stormwater use fee for equivalent residential unit shall be \$3.00 per month.

SECTION 2. The rate charge undisturbed property shall be determined by dividing the total square footage of the property by the square footage of an equivalent residential unit times a correction factor of 0.0% times the rate of an equivalent residential unit (ERU).


SECTION 3. The rates to be charged for nonresidential properties, i.e., all other occupants other than provided for in Sections 1 through Section 3 herein, shall be the rate established in Section 1 (\$3.00) multiplied by the number of equivalent residential units. The equivalent residential unit equals the total square footage of impervious area of the property divided by 3,137 square feet (statistically developed average for all the residential dwelling units in the City of Mason). Equivalent residential units will be rounded to the nearest tenth (0.1) of a unit.

SECTION 4. The rates to be charged for all residential dwelling units will be determined by multiplying 1.0 ERU by the fee for an ERU established in SECTION 1.

SECTION 5. The foregoing rates shall become effective for bills due on or after October 1, 2001 without penalty.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
