

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-22

PROCLAIMING JULY AS NATIONAL PARKS & RECREATION MONTH

WHEREAS, parks & recreation activities enhance the physical health and mental well-being of individuals, work forces, and communities; and

WHEREAS, participation in recreation programs builds self-esteem and provides positive and constructive alternatives to anti-social behavior; and

WHEREAS, parks & recreation opportunities and open space enhance the desirability of communities as locations for business, industry, and residential housing; and

WHEREAS, parks & recreation stimulates tourism revenues and the economic development of communities; and

WHEREAS, parks & open space are vital to the appearance and livability of communities, protect our air and water, and balance our ecosystem; and

WHEREAS, it is the right of everyone regardless of age, race, color, religion, gender, national origin or ability to participate in parks and recreation programs and activities and enjoy parks and open spaces; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason has made and continues to make considerable investments in park and recreational facilities and opportunities that enhance the quality of life for residents of the City of Mason.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio hereby designates and proclaims July, 2001 as National Parks & Recreation Month in the City of Mason, Ohio.


