

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-30

**REQUESTING THE OHIO POWER SITING BOARD TO FOLLOW
THE PREFERRED ROUTE ON THE PROPOSED C314 NATURAL GAS PIPELINE**

WHEREAS, City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the public safety of the City of Mason; and

WHEREAS, the preferred route for the proposed C314 Natural Gas Pipeline is least disruptive to the residences and business in the City of Mason and adjoining areas of Warren County; and

WHEREAS, the preferred route is the most economic route to pursue in the placement of the gas pipeline.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, Seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Mason strongly urges the Ohio Power Siting Board to pursue placement of the C314 Natural Gas Pipeline along the preferred route.


Section 2. That the City Council of the City of Mason expresses its cooperation in assisting in the pursuit of the preferred route for said Pipeline.
