

RESOLUTION 2001-31

Section 1. That David K. Batsche is hereby given the commendation of the Council of the City of Mason for his outstanding and distinguished service to said City.


Section 2. That the Clerk of Council be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to Judge David K. Batsche.
