

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-124

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GLOBE AMERADA ARCHITECTURAL GLASS TO PURCHASE SPECIALIZED GLAZING MATERIALS FOR \$10,525.56 FOR THE MUNICIPAL CENTER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, emergent circumstances have arisen under which it appears that the prime glass contractor for the new Municipal Center, Greenville Glass, is unable to itself secure the specialized glazing materials, including bulletproof glass which has already been prepared for the Mason Police Department area and the Mason Municipal Court Clerk's payment window, for the new Municipal Center; and

WHEREAS, Greenville Glass has given written authorization to the City of Mason to secure these specialized glazing materials and has agreed to reduce its prime contract amount by the amount which the City of Mason expends for these specialized glazing materials; and

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Mason, Section 5.04(J) authorizes Council to specify the amount for which supplies and materials may be purchased without advertisement and competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare that this ordinance be passed as an emergency ordinance under Section 4.07 of the Charter of the City of Mason, the specific necessity being the immediate need to complete the new Municipal Center by the September 2, 2002 project completion date, given that the City is planning and is under contract to move the large majority of its operations to the new Municipal Center later in September, 2002;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio six members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Globe Amerada Architectural Glass in for a sum not to exceed \$10,525.56, without advertising or competitive bidding, for the payment of two purchase orders for specialized glazing materials, including bulletproof glass for the Police Department area and Municipal Court Clerk's pay window, for the new Municipal Center, preparation of which has already been completed by Globe Amerada Architectural Glass;

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay to Globe Amerada Architectural Glass a sum not to exceed \$10,525.56 for these two purchase orders, upon receipt of the specialized glazing materials; and

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and shall be effective immediately upon passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete the new Municipal Center in time to accommodate the existing contractual

commitments of the City and the scheduled September, 2002 move of most city operations to the new Municipal Center; and the need to provide safe and secure facilities there.
