

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-130

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH JIM VEARIL CONCRETE AND EXCAVATING FOR REPAIR WORK TO A CONCRETE TANK AT THE WATER RECLAMATION PLANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, bids were received for the repair work to a concrete tank at the Water Reclamation Plant; and

WHEREAS, Jim Vearil Concrete and Excavating was the best bidder with a bid of \$21,650.00 for said work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Jim Vearil Concrete and Excavating in the amount of \$21,650.00 for repair work to a concrete tank at the Water Reclamation Plant is hereby accepted as the best bid.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Jim Vearil Concrete and Excavating for repair work to a concrete tank at the Water Reclamation Plant, according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby directed to pay said Jim Vearil Concrete and Excavating the sum of \$21,650.00 for said work.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the critical nature of the tank's function requires that the repair be made at the earliest possible date.
