

ORDINANCE NO. 2002- 149

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH SUNESIS CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE TYLERSVILLE ROAD BICYCLE & PEDESTRIAN WAY EXTENSION FROM US-42 TO SNIDER ROAD.

WHEREAS, bids have been received for the construction of the Tylersville Road bicycle & pedestrian way extension from US-42 to Snider Road; and

WHEREAS, Sunesis Construction Company is the lowest and best bidder with a bid of \$295,042.00 for said construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, five members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Sunesis Construction Company in the amount of \$295,042.00 is hereby accepted as the lowest and best bid for the construction of the Tylersville Road bicycle & pedestrian way extension from US-42 to Snider Road.

Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Sunesis Construction Company for the construction of the Tylersville Road bicycle & pedestrian way extension from US-42 to Snider Road, according to the specifications set forth by the City.


Section 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay said Sunesis Construction Company an amount not to exceed \$295,042.00 for said construction services.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
