

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-26

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROVIDE UP TO \$13,100 TO CINCINNATI METRO TO CONTINUE THE METRO 71/72 RUSH HOUR COMMUTE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICE FROM WARREN COUNTY TO THE CITY OF CINCINNATI**

WHEREAS, the City of Mason desires that public transportation service continue to and from the City of Cincinnati, and that can be accomplished through a collaborative effort among Warren County, the City of Mason, the City of Lebanon and Deerfield Township; and

WHEREAS, said funding will provide continued bus service to citizens of Warren County who rely on public transportation to get to their jobs in the City of Cincinnati; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mason will contribute up to \$13,100.00 to the Metro 71/72 Rush Hour Commuter service contingent upon the financial contribution of Warren County, the City of Lebanon and Deerfield Township to make up the total \$102,300.00 request; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:


Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Cincinnati Metro to provide funding of continued public transportation service to the City of Mason.

Section 2. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to pay up to \$13,100.00 to Cincinnati Metro to continue said service.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
