

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-86

**MODIFYING THE COMPENSATION FOR PROSECUTION SERVICES  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, 7 members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Robert W. Peeler, as the Prosecutor for the Mason Municipal Court, shall be paid \$58,000.00 per year, less any amount paid to him by Warren County. Additionally, said Prosecutor shall receive the same health care and other benefits provided for all full-time City employees.

Section 2. That said Prosecutor shall receive the amount of \$30,000.00 as a contribution toward the cost of providing the necessary Assistant Prosecutor(s) to meet the prosecutorial needs of the Mason Municipal Court.


Section 3. That said Prosecutor shall receive the amount of \$30,000.00 as a contribution toward the administrative costs incurred in running the Prosecutor's office, i.e., secretarial, paralegal and miscellaneous positions.

Section 4. That said Prosecutor, or his designated Assistant, shall perform the following duties: prosecute all matters in Mason Municipal Court, including tax matters and Building Code matters, as well as all other criminal and traffic matters, advise and counsel members of the City of Mason Police Department regarding these prosecutions, and handle all other matters that may arise related to prosecutions.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall be effective on and after January 1, 2002. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to have this Ordinance in effect at the earliest possible date.
