

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-92

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH  
KEN NEYER PLUMBING FOR THE PLUMBING CONSTRUCTION SERVICES  
NECESSARY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE HERITAGE OAK PARK  
RESTROOM AND PAVILION**

WHEREAS, bids were received for the plumbing construction services necessary for the construction of the Heritage Oak Park Restroom and Pavilion; and

WHEREAS, Ken Neyer Plumbing submitted the best bid in an amount not to exceed \$46,180.00 for said plumbing construction work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the bid of Ken Neyer Plumbing in the amount of \$46,180.00 for the plumbing construction services necessary for the construction of the Heritage Oak Park Restroom and Pavilion is hereby accepted as the best bid.


Section 2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ken Neyer Plumbing for said plumbing construction services, according to the specifications set forth by the City.


